

Proposed Road map for issue of Health Cards.

Chapters	Features
1. Scheme objects	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To provide cashless treatment to all Govt employees, teachers, workers and pensioners at NWHs in the state and identified hospitals at other states • Rs.3.00 lakhs per family on floater basis at all NWHs for all procedures. • Free OPD at all NWHs. • Free health check up yearly by all NWHs • Free medicines to chronic diseases. • Any additional expenditure will be met from the 'Corpus Fund' to be provided by the Govt. and the amount will be decided by a Technical committee to be formed and will be decided case by case. This will be done without causing any delay for treatment.
2. Separate Trust & its Administration	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Separate Trust for this purpose has to be formed immediately • Trust consists of Govt representatives and Representatives of the Assns/unions as agreed. • The Chief Secretary will be Chairman and the Convenor will be either Secretary GAD or Secretary M&H. • The trust will have an MOU with service provider to implement the scheme. • All the contributions by the Employees, teachers, workers and pensioners will be deposited into the A/c of this Trust.
3. Contributions / Corpus Fund	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • It is agreed to contribute Rs.90/- and Rs.120/- pm depending upon cadre. In case both the wife and husband are employees, either has to contribute and in case wife is willing, her parents will be included into the scheme. • The Govt agreed to provide Rs.175/- Crores as Corpus fund on replenishment basis. • The Share of Govt and the contributions will always remain at 60:40 ratio to be calculated every month/quarter. • The change in contributions will be taken up with PRC only. • The new trust will have full control to monitor the scheme like finances, selection of service provider, extension of benefit to any cadre of Govt employees, teachers, workers and pensioners.
4. Eligibility of employees	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All drawing salary from treasury/PAO/W&P. • Drawing salary from Govt grants, aided institutions, local bodies, Public Sector Institutions, Universities, Co-operative institutions and Zilla parishad and Panchayat Raj Institutions.
5. Administration / Maintenance of Data / issue of Cards	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All the information will be collected and maintained by the DTA/PAO and issue of cards by the DTO/PAO at Dist. level. • Service provider (AHCT) and the NWHs will be allowed to access the data of DTA/PAO.
6. Service providers	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The service provider will be decided by the New trust to be formed. In principle the AHCT will provide the services for first two years after an MOU with the Trust. • AHCT will be the member of the New trust as long as it remain as service provider..

The Govt have to give a signed approach paper on the above points (chapters) and the JAC will have an agreement with the Govt on the agreed items and the GOs may be issued subsequently for implementation of the scheme of health cards.
